

Instructions for canvassers:

1. Only persons who are 18 years old, a Canadian citizen, resident of Regina for three months and resident of Saskatchewan for six months are “electors” and therefore eligible to sign this petition. Please ask everyone who sign if they meet these eligibility requirements. If persons sign who are not eligible, their signatures don't count towards the required number of signatures we must gather.
2. The information requested on the petition is the information required by *The Cities Act*. If all the information is not present, the signature will not count. In particular, you must witness the signature of EACH person who signs. Make sure you sign in the blank provided.
3. When you have completed a page, please print your name and address and phone number on the page before you hand it in.
4. Completed pages may be handed in to Merrilee Rasmussen at 2237 Smith Street, during office hours, or at 2816 Victoria Avenue outside of office hours.
5. If you cannot deliver your completed pages, phone Merrilee at 537-6607 and she will make arrangements to pick them up from you.
6. Hand in pages as often as possible. The Friends of the Regina Public Library will endeavour to verify signatures on an on-going basis and keep a count. It's easier to spread this work out over time, so hand sheets in whenever you have any of them completed.
